Advanced Civics / Advanced Economics Capstone Project Options

## Mr. -----

There are three options for students to choose from. Option #2 is very likely the most straight-forward option, but may not be the best/ most enjoyable option for all students.

## Option #1

Students may complete a National History Day Project and compete in the Regional History Day Competition. Your History Day project will be **due to Mr. ------ by February 9**<sup>th</sup>. The actual competition is **Saturday**, March 4<sup>th</sup>. Rubrics for a grade on this project will be forthcoming (as they may vary based on the category that you compete in).

You can compete as a solo project. You can also compete in a group of 2-5 students, but your group members must all be in Mr. -----'s pre-AP Civics/ pre-AP Economics class. They don't all have to be in the same *section* of the class, but it would be helpful.

A quick summary of categories for entry is here:

NHD offers five creative categories in each division. The Documentary, Exhibit, Performance, and Website categories offer both individual and group participation options. The Paper category allows individual participation only. Groups may include two to five students. Group members do not have to be in the same grade, but all must be in sixth grade or above. The group project must enter the division of the oldest group member.
